Justice and Peace Law

Confessions:

48,541 homicides, **1,755** massacres, **9,918** forced displacement, **4,812**, forced disappearances, **2,834** illegal recruitment, **1,797** extortion.

Official requests to investigate other public authorities: 442 politicians, **417** members of the armed forces and **161** public servants.

Registered Victims: 334,916.

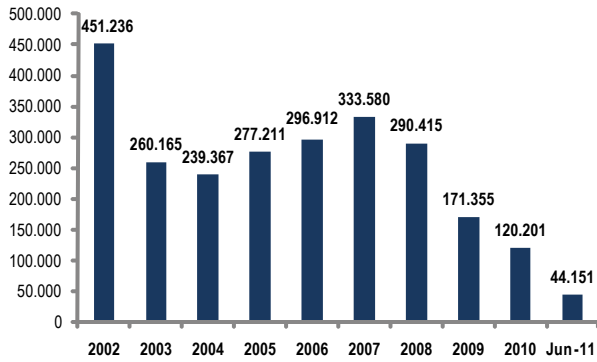
Victims who received attention in 616 sessions: 120,711

669 individuals who have entered into Justice and Peace have asked the victims for forgiveness, **525** have publicly repented and **577** have promised never to repeat punishable behaviors.

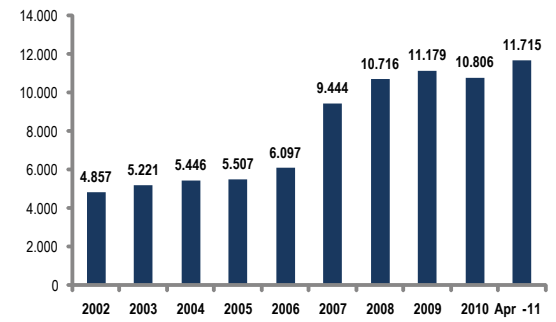
Displaced persons

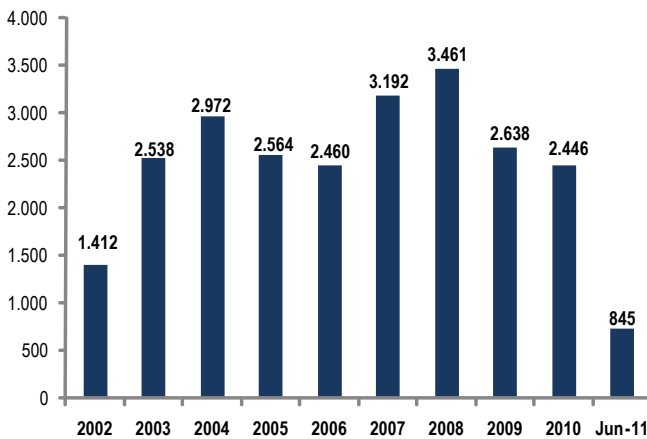
Between January and June 2011, a total of **54,814 displaced families** were supported in their return to their homes or relocation.

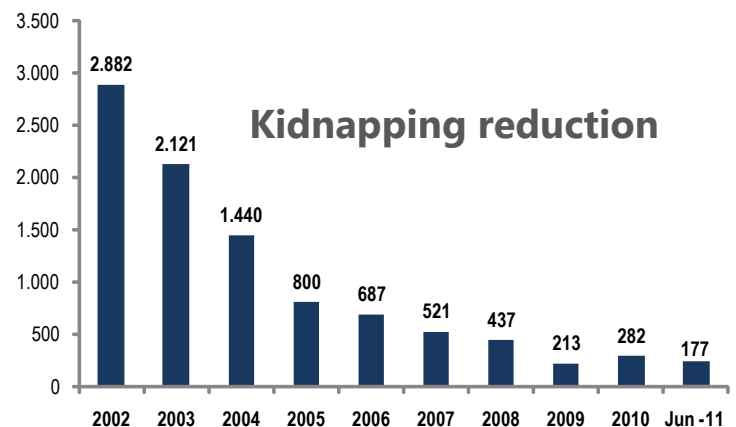
Forest – keeping families
