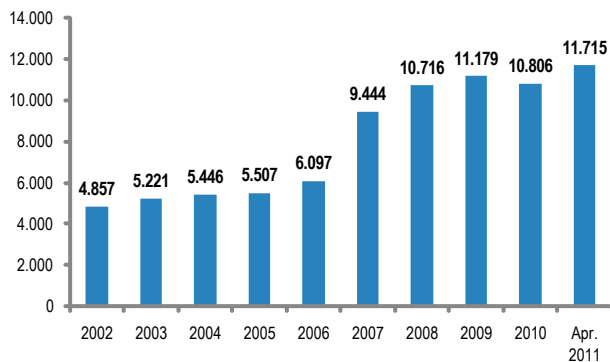

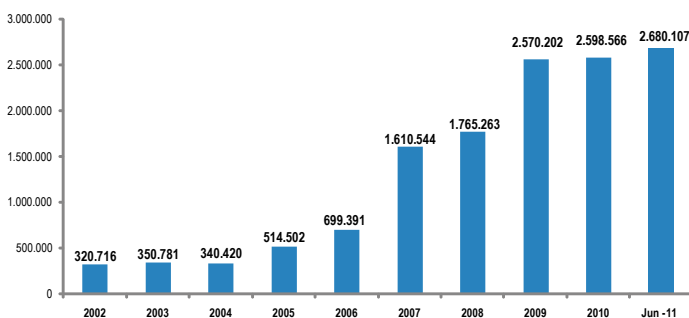


Total population benefited by protection program

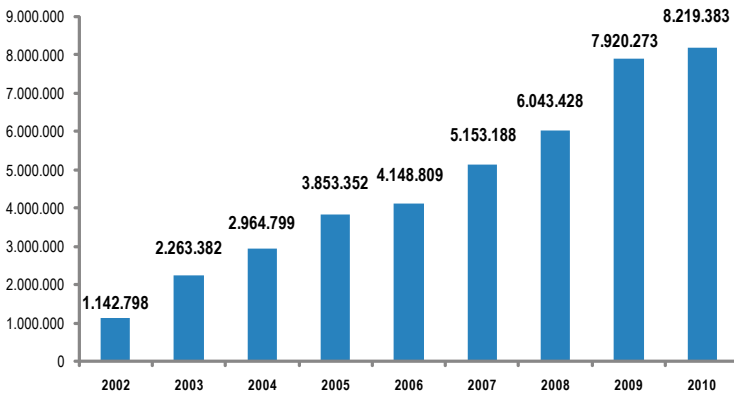

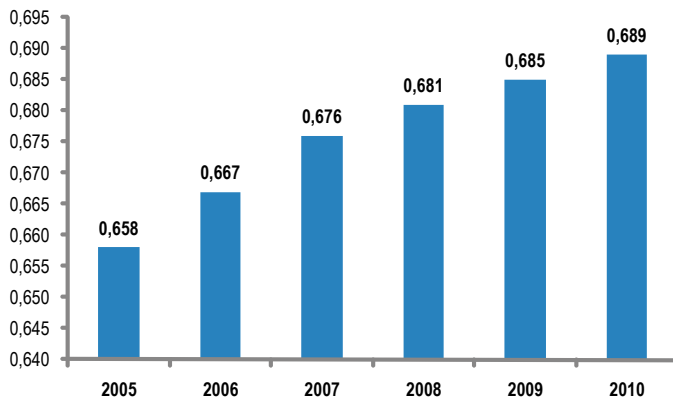

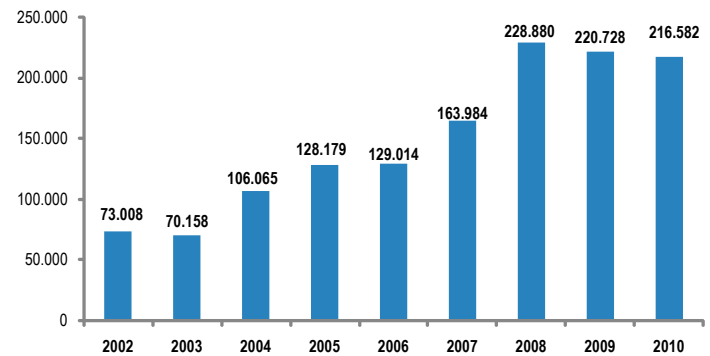

Human development index

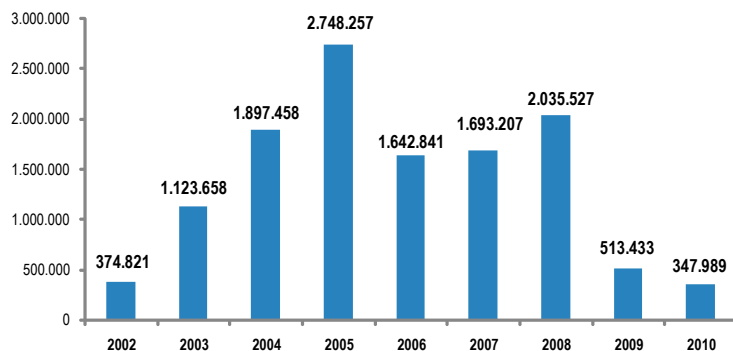


Subsidies and credits for Social interest housing
